


Finally...

Give & Take!

The Government's decision to apply full business rates on all empty offices after three months may prove costly for commercial property owners. In addition, warehouses and industrial units will be subject to full business rates after six months of being empty. With many company pension schemes buying commercial property in the last few years, new owners will be eager for tenants. At least the Government has found of way of replacing lost revenue from the sharp reduction in stamp duty due to the collapse of the housing market!

HIPs (or Home Improvement Packs) came into effect last year for the sale of all domestic property. To be introduced on 1st October 2008 is the requirement for all rented property to have an EPC or Energy Performance Certificate. An EPC will last for ten years. Property that is tenanted before 1st October 2008 will not require an EPC until it is next vacated.

It seems we can't get away without mentioning the 'Credit Crunch'. As one buoyant company director said "Credit Crunch, we eat it for breakfast!" Our Environment

The 1,000 acre Hexgreave Estate is part of the Countryside Stewardship scheme which allows us to enhance and preserve our English landscape, its wildlife and history. We do this partly by keeping wide margins of grass around the fields to protect the hedges and trees in order to create habitat for wildlife. We also plant large areas as wild bird feed. The RSPCA carried out a survey at Hexgreave in 2003 and we are pleased to notice an increasing variety amongst the wild birds, especially with wild fowl down on the lake.

The number of red deer in the park has risen substantially with this years young calves born in June. We even had two sets of twins, it is very rare for red deer to have twins; so two sets is guite unique.

Commodity prices have been in the news with reports of high increases in their value. One factor not reported however, is the very high increase in input costs at the same time, for example the cost of fertilizer has increased by as much as 100%. However, house prices have slumped but land prices have increased with arable values being driven by increased food and oil prices.

Interestingly...

It appears the estate is home to the largest Wellingtonian tree in Nottinghamshire. One was previously recorded in the county with a circumference of 5.45 metres, ours measures a massive 6.80 metres this apparently dates the tree at about 140 years old. The first seeds of the Wellingtonian or Redwood tree, from the west coast at America, were introduced in England in 1853; ours could be one of the first!
